RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The event is organised by Southampton Magna Rotary Club.
- 2. The event is open to any car or light commercial vehicle <u>registered before 1st</u> <u>January 1976</u>. Interesting or quality vehicles built after 1975 may be accepted at the discretion of the organisers. Heavy commercial vehicles and motorcycles are not permitted to enter.
- 3. The organisers reserve (without question) the right to refuse entry to any vehicle or its occupant(s) before the event, and its, and/or their, continuation at any time during the event itself.
- 4. Entries will be accepted from owners of vehicles conforming to these regulations. An entrant for the purposes of these regulations need not be a member of any motor club, but must be the legal owner of the vehicle or his/her duly appointed representative.
- 5. The driver(s) shall be the person(s) whose name(s) appear on the entry form.
- 6. The entries open with the publication of these regulations and <u>close 14 days prior to</u> <u>the event.</u> Please get your entries in as soon as possible as vehicle numbers are limited.
- 7. If an entry is cancelled by the entrant, the fee will be refunded less 10%, provided cancellation is received <u>in writing/email by the closing date.</u> Likewise, if an entrant wishes to change the vehicle entered, this change must be notified by the closing date.
- 8. After the closing date no refunds will be made, unless the event is cancelled by the organisers, in which case a full refund will be made.
- 9. In the spirit of the friendly nature of the event, participants agree not to hold the organisers and their helpers liable and accept responsibility for themselves, their passengers & their vehicles which must be in a roadworthy condition and comply with all legal requirements ie a) Have a valid road fund licence, b) be covered by valid insurance and c) hold a current MOT certificate or international equivalent; (unless it is a British vehicle exempt from the MOT test by virtue of age).
- 10. The start will be in the New Forest; **details will be sent after the closing date**. Starting time for the first car (the oldest) will be **10.00a.m.** and the finishing time will be approximately **4.30p.m.** Any driver who has not signed in at least half an hour before his/her start time will be deemed to be a non-starter.
- 11. A route sheet will be issued. Map reading knowledge is not required. The total distance of this event is about 75 miles, or 45 miles for pre-1914 vehicles.
- 12. Entries will only be accepted if accompanied by the entry fee. If more than one car is to be entered, please use a separate form. (good photocopies are acceptable or see the website for a form).
- 13. Entry fee will be £40 per car.
- 14. Charity donations will be accepted from non car owners wishing to ride in a car, provided there are seats available.
